DuPage River Park Bridge Renovation Project

Temporary DuPage River Trail Closure and Detour Information

The purpose of this project is to remove an existing wood bridge along the DuPage River Trail nearby the Naperville Park District's DuPage River Park. The wood bridge has reached the end of its usable lifespan, and will be replaced with box culverts that will allow the water to continue flowing through the area during rain events. The box culverts will be paved over with asphalt and will appear the same as the rest of the DuPage River Trail. Finally, the landscaping in the project area will be seeded with turf grass and a wet prairie seed mixture as part of the restoration phase.

The project is slated to commence the week of July 31 with the goal to reach substantial completion before the month of September.

Throughout the project, a detour will be provided for the portion of the DuPage River Trail that will be closed to trail users during construction. The detour includes the residential neighborhood just north of Royce Road and will direct users back to the DuPage River Trail at the earliest possible entry point. See below detour map.
